Information regarding marriage licenses:

The County Clerk issues marriage licenses.

The fee for a formal marriage license is \$82.00.

The fee for an informal marriage declaration is \$47.00.

Both applicants must appear in person and have valid government-issued identification (state-issued driver's license or identification card, passport, resident card or military identification). It is allowed to have an absent application done, but marriage by proxy is **NOT ALLOWED** to anyone who is not actively deployed military in a combat zone.

An applicant cannot be divorced within the last 30 days. If an applicant has been divorced in the last 30 days, the applicant must furnish a certified copy of the divorce decree which states the judge signing has waived the 30-day requirement.

Applicants cannot be presently married, unless married to each other.

An applicant who is delinquent in court-ordered child support must answer that he or she is delinquent.

Applicants cannot be related by either blood or adoption.

Due to the length of time it takes to complete the application and license in office, applicants are required to appear no later than 3:45 PM for a marriage license.

Per LGC 118.018(d) the Clerk's office may charge an additional \$100 fee to out of state applicants. This fee will be waived for active duty military personnel with proper identification.
