NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.719914 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Newton County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.719914 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.719914 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.824559 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Newton County from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Newton County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Newton County is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 29, 2022 AT 10:00 AM AT District Courtroom, 2nd Floor Newton County Courthouse, 110 Court St., Newton, TX 75966.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Newton County is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Newton County Commissioners' Court of Newton County at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Newton County last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Newton County this year.
