Long-Term Planning and Recovery

Below is an explanation of how the region's method of distribution fosters long-term community recovery that is forward-looking and focused on permanent restoration of infrastructure, housing and the local economy.

Due to the limited amount of Disaster Recovery CDBG funding available, the Method of Distribution focused on the most affected areas of the County. Discussion of the Commissioners and County Judge resulted in prioritizing the projects by assisting the most affected areas first. Priority will be established to address the most urgent unmet housing needs and then infrastructure that will help alleviate future flooding impacts. Forward-looking, long-term recovery will include a long range comprehensive master plan for the County which will identify flood and hazard resilient locations and construction standards for housing and housing related infrastructure and facilities. Long-term planning projects will be based on principles of mitigation, future resiliency and permanent restoration and improvement of community assets.

Unmet Housing Needs

Below is an explanation of how unmet housing needs will be addressed or how economic revitalization or infrastructure activities will contribute to long-term recovery and restoration of housing in the most impacted and distressed areas.

Priority will be established to address the most urgent unmet housing needs first. Unmet housing needs will be addressed by focusing on elevation, relocation, and restoration of LMI households with verified losses in the most distressed areas. Infrastructure activities will contribute to long-term recovery by improving the safety, resiliency and quality of community assets, which in turn will support future housing development in the County and long-term recovery.

Method of Distribution Detail

The County is required to prepare a method of distribution between the eligible entities or projects. The GLO has directed the County to use a direct allocation technique based on objective, verifiable data. The Method of Distribution will identify how it meets benefiting 70% low-to-moderate persons requirement., supports minimum allocation amounts that help ensure project feasibility, and provides an explanation of the distribution factors selected.

Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing Statement

All subrecipients will certify that they will affirmatively further fair housing ("AFFH") in their grant agreements, and will receive GLO training and technical assistance in meeting their AFFH obligations. Additionally, all project applications will undergo AFFH review by GLO before approval. Such review will include assessment of a proposed project's area demography, socioeconomic characteristics, housing configuration and needs, educational, transportation, and health care opportunities, environmental hazards or concerns, and all other factors material to the AFFH determination. Applications should show that projects are likely to lessen area racial, ethnic, and low-income concentrations, and/or promote affordable housing in low-poverty, nonminority areas in response to natural hazard related impacts.



Burkeville Meeting 5/22/2017:

We have poor residents. We need basketball courts, etc, recreation for the youth so they can have something to do besides getting in trouble.

Cade Building is used during disasters. It was used during the floods for FEMA, Red Cross, and to distribute donations of food, clothing, etc. to residents in need. The building needs a generator and the roof repaired. Roads are also a concern.

Lives on CR 1083. Road is muddy. Water washes off road under trailer and washes away foundation.

Deweyville and Bon Wier should be top priority. Hire case workers to do home assessments. Need declaration of wind damage in Newton County. Infrastructure; Liberty Community without water tied to Newton City water for 90 days. Need new well and infrastructure. Also, youth, gymnasium.

Roads in the Wiergate area need to be upgraded.

Houses should be main concern.

Houses have water go in to them because of the road conditions. Elderly need help with their houses.

Lost home, very expensive to re-level home. Funds for housing.

Lost home. Believes it is SRA's fault. Was explained to him that the County is not associated with the SRA.

Newton Meeting 5/22/2017:

Wants to know how many houses affected. Wants to give the money to the people to do what they want with it.

Wants community back. Homes, farm equipment destroyed. FEMA didn't help enough. She only got ½ enough. Her mother house destroyed, lady's daughter lived there, received no money because it was not her principle residence.

Need apartments in Bon Wier area. Business affected.

Use money for job creation, state park, train VFDs, drainage

Drainage – standing water causes health problems. Need mosquito spray program.

Use funds for homes. Keep citizens updated.

Not enough money allocated to Newton County. Believes people will not get help.

Feels like Old Salem community will get over looked.

Homes, businesses. Need something to keep water back when river goes up.

Housing – some still out of houses. Some in houses, but house not ready or unlivable. Money needs to go to residents.

Desires to rebuild community. Does not want to leave.

Wants public involved in how to use money. Concerned that people lied on FEMA applications. People do not trust government.

Majority of money should go for human welfare, people affected by floods.

Roads. Needs should already be assessed. Damage should already be taken care of. Liberty Community needs money for water system.

Needs more clarification. Who is over grant? Permits, what can be done with homes, new FEMA maps, reimbursement of money used to fix home, who to talk with to get questions answered, how long will projects take?

Only received \$400 from FEMA. Had to move because damage was too great. Use money for homes, use other grants for roads.

Creeks full of debris causing backup (Cow Creek CR 2460).

Written comment received, 5/22/17 (summarized): Waterways need to be cleaned of trees and debris that has built up over time, so that flooding will be alleviated.

Deweyville Meeting 5/23/17

Had to relocate. Asked about SRA issues.

Lost everything and rebuilt. Wants money back that was spent.

Issues with raising house.

Wants clarification – about FEMA maps, permits, grant administration. Put citizens' homes first.

Housing. Does not know why she has to raise her house another foot. Why is she in another zone?

Questions about how long before projects and money gets started. Are we working on it now?

Since this is a reimbursement grant, does the County have enough money to get started? Wants to know how the survey results will be computed and published for the public to see.

Concern that the school needs to take care of themselves and money go to housing.

Distribute the money proportionately to the areas that have the most damage. Concentrate on elderly and veterans first.

Concern about pending FEMA flood maps; cannot make decisions without the final maps. The school needs help to rebuild.

School – damage assessment was included in determining total damages in County. School needs 5-6 million to complete the funding to rebuild. Also concerned about where to rebuild school.

Concern for CR 3113. Homes on road did not flood, but road is bad when it rains. School buses and people cannot get in or out because of road conditions. Safety concerns.

Question about elevation requirements.

Concerned FEMA flood maps are off.

Why hasn't anything been done before to railroad tracks south of town. They hold back the flood waters.

Wants solutions!

SRA is a problem. Holds water back then has to release and creates flooding.

Concerned about taxes increasing because of the houses that are rebuilt.
